

The providers manage routine healthcare—not only well-child care, but also asthma, allergies, eczema, obesity, and hypertension. They also case manage with other specialists and their specific recommendations. Some of the procedures done in the office are vaccinations; urinalysis; rapid strep, flu, and RSV tests; ear washes; removal of foreign bodies; nebulizer treatments; cauterization; and cryotherapy.
